- Concerning history/clinical presentation:
 - Persistent fevers, and respiratory symptoms
- Abnormal labs:
 - Lymphocyte <0.8K/uL; Ferritin >500ng/mL; CRP >10 mg/dL; D-dimer >1ug/mL FEU
- Imaging with stereotypical pattern:
 - CT: Multi-lobar bilateral ground glass opacities
 - CXR: Bilateral lung infiltrates
- Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS)
- Septic Shock without alternate source
- Multi-organ failure without alternate source
